





### Reflections from The Vicarage...

Autumn is definitely here. No more hoping for the Indian summer we were promised, although the beginning of October had a glimpse of it, and I don't doubt that we will still have some sunny days. The nights are drawing in and if we are out and about, we will not take a jumper or coat 'in case it turns chilly', but rather head out dressed for wind and rain and with a brolly in the bag!

Many of us often dream about escaping to live in a sunny climate, but for me, one of the delights of living in England is the seasons and I treasure each one for different reasons. **Remembrance Sunday:** We intend to hold an event at our new memorial on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November this year. The details are yet to be decided, but we are aiming for a time of day so as to not clash with Church Remembrance Services. Arrangements will be published in the usual places.

**Salt Bins:** Living in Northamptonshire it must be almost impossible not to know of the financial difficulties the County

Council faces, and some of this has started to be passed on to us. The County will no longer be replenishing all of the salt bins but the Parish Council feels that this presents a risk to people using our highways and have agreed to take on the burden of paying for and filling most of our salt bins. This is an addition to our already set budget, so we ask that everyone acts responsibly and only uses the salt from the bins for highways. Should salt be taken for 'personal' use, there is a real risk that it will not be available when needed.

**Dog Owners:** And finally, a precautionary tale for dog walkers. Recently people in the County have been fined for failing to clear up after their dogs. The excuse that a bag was forgotten (or the dog bag dispenser was empty or jammed) did not prevent them being fined. It is our responsibility as dog owners to take suitable facilities with us when we leave our house for clearing up after our animals and not rely on the dispenser – which is realistically there for emergencies only.

#### News from around the Diocese - Remembering the fallen

St Andrew's Church in Cotterstock will be commemorating Armistice Day on Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th November with a huge poppy installation created by artist Angela Wright.


back that pleas were made for her to return to help the village honour the 100th anniversary



#### On the Home Front World War II



My earliest memory is that of the bomb. Not the bang, I don't remember that, but of being thrown by my mother into our Anderson shelter and landing on top of my sister who my mother had thrown down the steps a split second before. My older sister was screaming and my mother was telling us to sing and I couldn't make out what the problem

was, why was my sister crying? Why was my mother telling us to sing?

What I don't remember was that earlier in the day my mother had taken us into town shopping and on the way there we met the lady from next door but one with her little girl. The little girl was highly excited and showed us her new pair of bright red shoes and told us that when she got home she was going to put them on and dance and dance and dance.

Then came the afternoon, we were in the garden and my mother was taking the washing from the line when 'Tugboat Annie' sounded. 'Tugboat Annie' was the imminent warning that sounded just like a ship's hooter and followed the usual air raid siren, but that day there'd been no time for sirens to tell us something bad was on the way. Dad ran next door to make sure that the old lady who lived there was safe just as a dive bomber started his attack. Mum picked my sister and me up and threw us into the Anderson just as the bomb went off.

My dad was really lucky, as he was going into next door the bomb exploded and the only injury he had was a bump on the head when his head smacked into the door, my mum said later that she didn't expect to see him alive again. The old lady was uninjured but only next door to them, the little girl along with her mother and seven other people died.

I often think of that little girl and she is always the first person that comes to mind on Remembrance Day. She'd have probably been a grandmother by now but I like to imagine her in her own little patch of heaven wearing those bright red shoes and dancing, dancing, dancing.

#### Gardeners Corner November 2018 By Alistair Peak of PGS

November is the real start of winter, the clocks have gone back giving us all less time in the garden, however, there is still plenty to be done and to enjoy at this time of year. Trees, shrubs and many herbaceous plants will still provide lots of interest including the colour of leaves (if evergreen), coloured bark and even the flowers of plants like pansies.

Do not shut the back door on the garden yet! Clear any remaining leaves off the lawns, if left it will kill the grass. More importantly if you have paths with hard surfaces that you use regularly keep them clear otherwise they become lethal to walk on.

Greenhouses are wonderful places to grow tender plants along with over wintering plants that require some protection from the worst of the winter weather. If you heat your greenhouse make sure that its well insulated to prevent heat loss, sometimes you can make a mini green house within the main green house so that you do not have to heat the whole area. Check your heaters on a regular basis to ensure they are working efficiently. When watering plants in the greenhouse remember to keep them on the drier side otherwise they will rot off, and when watering try and keep to the minimum and do at the start of the day if you can. Keep an eye on the weather, if we get a warm day the greenhouse can become very warm quickly and can even scorch the plants with the heat. If warm do not be afraid to open the doors or vents for some fresh air.

As herbaceous plants die down some continue to provide winter interest such as seed heads. Others will just go black and require cutting back. Clearing now will tidy up your borders ready for applying mulch.

If you have not finished planting your spring bulbs do so ASAP, more importantly your tulips as this is the perfect time to get them planted. With outdoor pots ensure you raise them off the ground to prevent water logging, use feet of some description, either official pot feet, slate or small bricks. Keep an eye on them to check they are not too dry over the winter.

#### Alistair Tip:

Remember last winter? Keep feeding the feathered friends that visit your garden and provide fresh clean water, especially when its frozen.

#### Trusting in God's care

few weeks ago I was privileged to join hundreds of people in the Cathedral for a fascinating and deeply moving lecture by the TV historian Dr Janina Ramirez. Her subject was the 14th century spiritual writer Dame (some would say "Saint") Julian of Norwich.

Julian is sometimes called the "Mother of English Litera-



ture" and her astonishing book *Revelations of Divine Love* is widely regarded as the first great work of English prose. It was the fruit of 20 years of reflection upon a series of mystical visions of Jesus. She had prayed for a deeper understanding of the depth of God's love, and was given a life-changing glimpse into the suffering of Jesus' passion. Pope Francis has recently mentioned her, writing that "In one of her visions, Julian of Norwich hears the Lord say that he rejoices eternally because he was able to suffer for our sake out of love".

Dr Ramirez describes it as "an exceptional book" which offers "timeless insights into God, love, sin, suffering – all in a form of poetic prose that is unique, beautiful and powerfully moving". Julian's words about God's care through Christ have offered hope and comfort to many during times of pain or suffering.

Probably her best-known reflection is the famous "hazelnut" passage: He showed me a little thing, a hazelnut, lying in the palm of my hand. And it was as round as any ball. I looked upon it with the eye of my understanding, and thought, "What may this be?" And it was answered generally thus, "It is all that is made". I marvelled how it might last, for I thought it might suddenly have fallen to nothing for littleness. And I was answered in my understanding: It lasts and ever shall, for God loves it. In this little thing I saw three properties. The first is that God made it. The second that God loves it. And the third, that God keeps it.

As we approach the season of remembering All Saints, All Souls and the 100th anniversary of the Armistice which ended the First World War, it's good to be reassured by that reminder that God made us, loves us and will keep us.
